

Blax

Material The Blax collection is made from new, black stained and brushed oak veneer with sleek, black painted metal bases. The characteristic of the Blax collection is the geometric cube shapes on the doors and tops.

Maintenance In order to keep your furniture looking at its best it is important to maintain your Blax furniture properly, as you would do with other items that you cherish.

Remove stains immediately; do NOT rub the spill but dab it with a paper towel or an absorbing cloth. Do NOT use or apply any furniture maintenance products containing silicone or solvents like: stain removers, turpentine or white-spirit.

Stains can be removed with water and mild natural soap if necessary. Be careful with cleaning products containing bleach additives (lemon for example).

Abrasive cleaning products shouldn't be used at all. The frame can be best wiped with a soft and if needed damp cloth. Never use abrasive sponges and detergents with abrasives because these can leave scratches in the polished top layer.

This way you will keep your furniture looking at its best and it will last forever.
